- To get personal contacts with them
 - To provide the counselling

 - Workshops (easy and short, positive learning experience, socialisation)
 - Short-term work-related training courses (practical value, new skills, socialisation)
 - Counselling and career-guidance (the changing nature of career, facing life-long challenges)

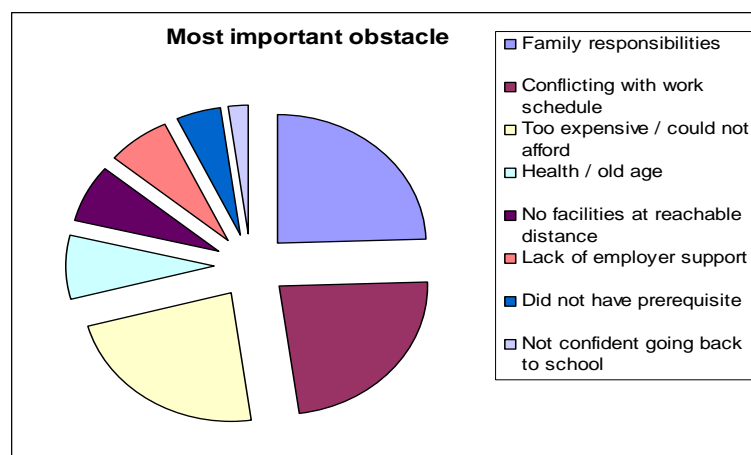
- Learning is a key to better, healthier and richer life!

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THE MAIN PROBLEMS:

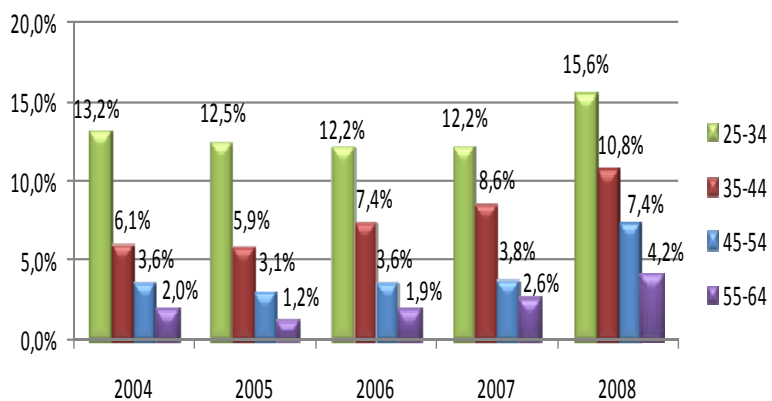
- It's more difficult to involve non-estonians and people with lower level of education

- Limited courses and training possibilities in non-formal education



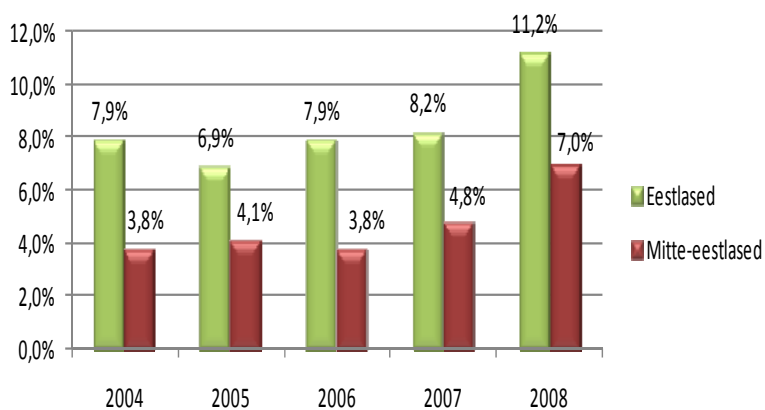
REASONS WHY PEOPLE ARE NOT STUDYING
