



## Homework for the meeting in Bristol in March 2010

- a)** Make a dissemination plan for your organisation extending two years after the end of the project.

The plan should include all the means and tools you (your organisation) intend to use in disseminating and exploiting the results of UVAL. It can be roughly estimated in terms of scheduling, meaning that the planned activities can be displayed “termwise” (that is to make a plan for each spring and another for each autumn).

Include both organisational (internal) and external activities. External activities can be local, regional or even national. They can include distributing flyers, posters or other such material or referring to web pages or handbook in different occasions, such as interviews, fairs or partner meetings.

The plans have to be ready by the meeting in the UK in March 2010. Remember to activate your organisation and its leaders to take part in the planning as it is a plan for the whole community. The project coordinator will monitor the execution of the plan biannually.

- b)** Reflect the past seminars and workshops and choose three aspects from each seminar that are most important in your opinion. Focus on the theme of each meeting and leave out the social and other activities that are not directly connected with the actual theme based content. In the meeting in Bristol we'll choose from these aspects the ones that are most often mentioned and include them in the handbook.
